


QHN has been a fully operational health information exchange (HIE) for 12 years and the QHN data repository has more than 20 million clinical results.

Consequently some patients may have thousands of results. When viewing a patient with a large quantity of data the data displayed is reduced to the last 60 days to improve loading times.

- If patient has a large quantity of data the below message in the blue box will appear noting that the data displayed has been limited to the last 60 days
