


As of January 2022, QHN users with access to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) documents can also find the info via OpiSafe.




**After a user has done a patient search, they will select OpiSafe under the Patient Actions**

If you are using OpiSafe for the first time, you will need to set up your access. A new window will open. Select your State and click Continue.

Next, enter your PDMP Account Username, PDMP Password and confirm. Check the box to grant agent authorization. Select Connect PDMP/PMP Account.

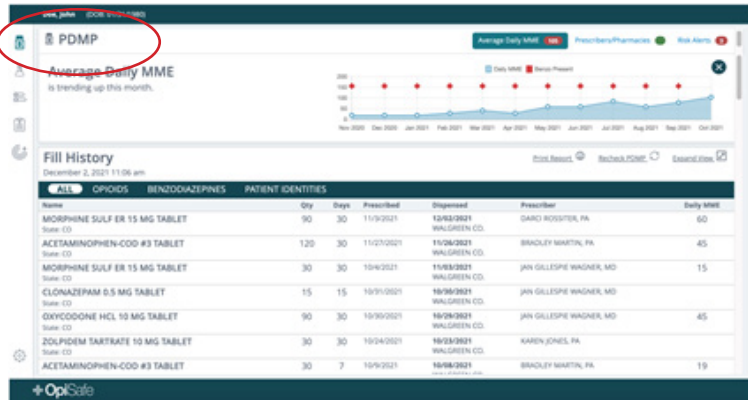

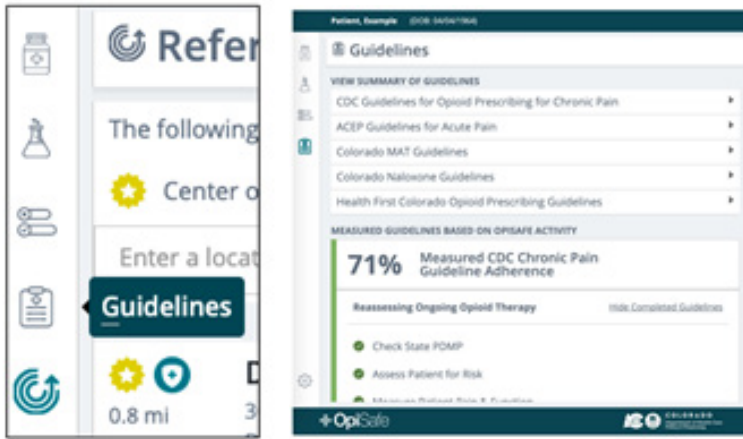

No user intervention is required.

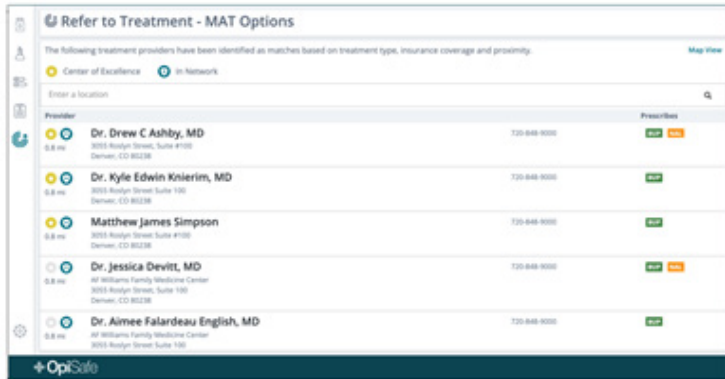
# Available options: Refer to Treatment- MAT Options

When you click on the treatment locator icon, the system will search multiple sources and return a list of medication assisted providers by location, insurance coverage, and type of services.

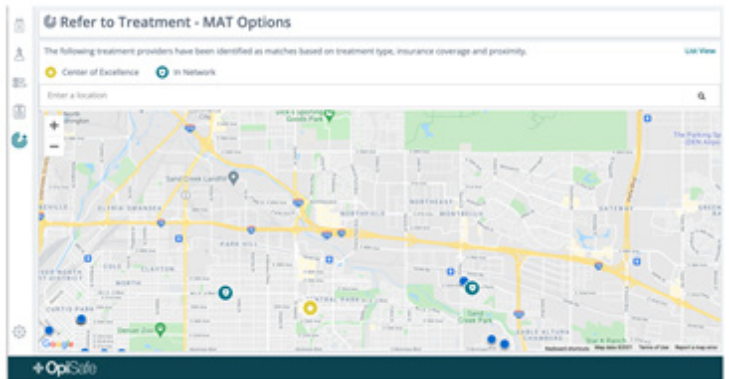
The providers can be viewed in a list view or map view.
